

Work Experience

The work experience programme offers our fourth year students the opportunity to experience, first hand, the world of work. It is an excellent opportunity for students to develop their organisational skills, confidence and independence. During work experience pupils can see first-hand what happens in a typical day on the job. Getting a realistic idea of the positive and negative parts of a job can help them to make a more informed career choice.

Meeting people in the job also helps students to start building a network of contacts in an industry they are interested in, which can help them to find a job later on. It also provides opportunities to learn about related jobs in the same field, which could give them more ideas about what kind of career to might go into.

Work experience often allows pupils to identify the links between their school curriculum and the industries they eventually aspire to work in. Being able to see this connection for themselves can inspire pupils to achieve their potential academically and can encourage them into positive and rewarding post school destinations.
